What is the age requirement?

In order to participate in the Student Missions Project, applicants must be completing either their Junior or Senior year of High School in 2018.

How many program participants are accepted?

One student will be selected.

What will my responsibilities be for the application?

Complete the application and return by the deadline. You will be monitored each day by HNCamp staff of your character and daily responsibilities but are not limited to: assisting staff, participating in activities, leadership qualities, caring for the campus, working with other campers, mentoring, activities with peers, etc.

What is the goal of this program?

The ultimate goal of the Student Missions Project is to disciple high school students and provide a unique environment of spiritual growth.

What does interaction with staff look like?

Applicants are encouraged to build relationships with camp staff during open time and while assisting staff during daily activities. While there are no required times of relationship building between campers and Summer Staff, it will be encouraged and expected.

What does interaction with campers look like?
